FREQUENCY DISTRIBUTION OF RESPONSES ON TEACHER





Frequency Distribution of responses (Qn 1: The teacher has enhanced my thinking ability.)






Frequency Distribution of responses (Qn 2: The teacher has increased my interest in the subject.)


